TIPPING GUIDE

Tipping in Europe is not compulsory, and often not expected. You are traveling on an independent itinerary and the cost of your program does not include gratuities. Tipping is a very personal matter and should only be considered when the staff have gone above and beyond for you. Should you feel you would like to acknowledge their service, please consider the following as a rough guide, per person per service.

RESTAURANTS

Some restaurants automatically add an 8-10% service charge to your bill. It's customary to add about 10-15% to the bill in restaurants, if the service has been satisfactory.

TAXIS

Taxi drivers do not expect to be tipped but they appreciate the fare being rounded up.

GUARDIAN ANGELS

Transfer assistance is at your discretion but if a Guardian Angel performs a special service for you, it would be appropriate to tip him or her the same rate you would tip a hotel concierge for similar assistance.

Note: When utilizing the hotel concierge through you or your travel advisor, we recommend tipping \$20-100 based on the services rendered.
